St. Matthew's Church was located upstream of Salem's drinking water supply, within Windham's Watershed Wetlands Protection District (WWPD). A variance allowing construction within the WWPD was needed. The Town of Windham Zoning Board granted a variance with the condition that "the function of the buffer within the WWPD must be replicated and no stormwater shall be discharged from the site without being treated".

SFC incorporated designs in the site plan that actually improved water quality after expansion. The site plan met the criteria set by Windham's Zoning Board and was approved. In addition, because the design did not compromise Salem's drinking water supply, the Town of Salem also approved the plan.

SFC also provided structural engineering of the building. The unique design incorporates the cross shape with true cathedral ceilings throughout, as well as the raised windowed cupola located at the center of the four ridges, which supports the steeple.
